**D IS FOR DIPLODOCUS AND DIGESTION**

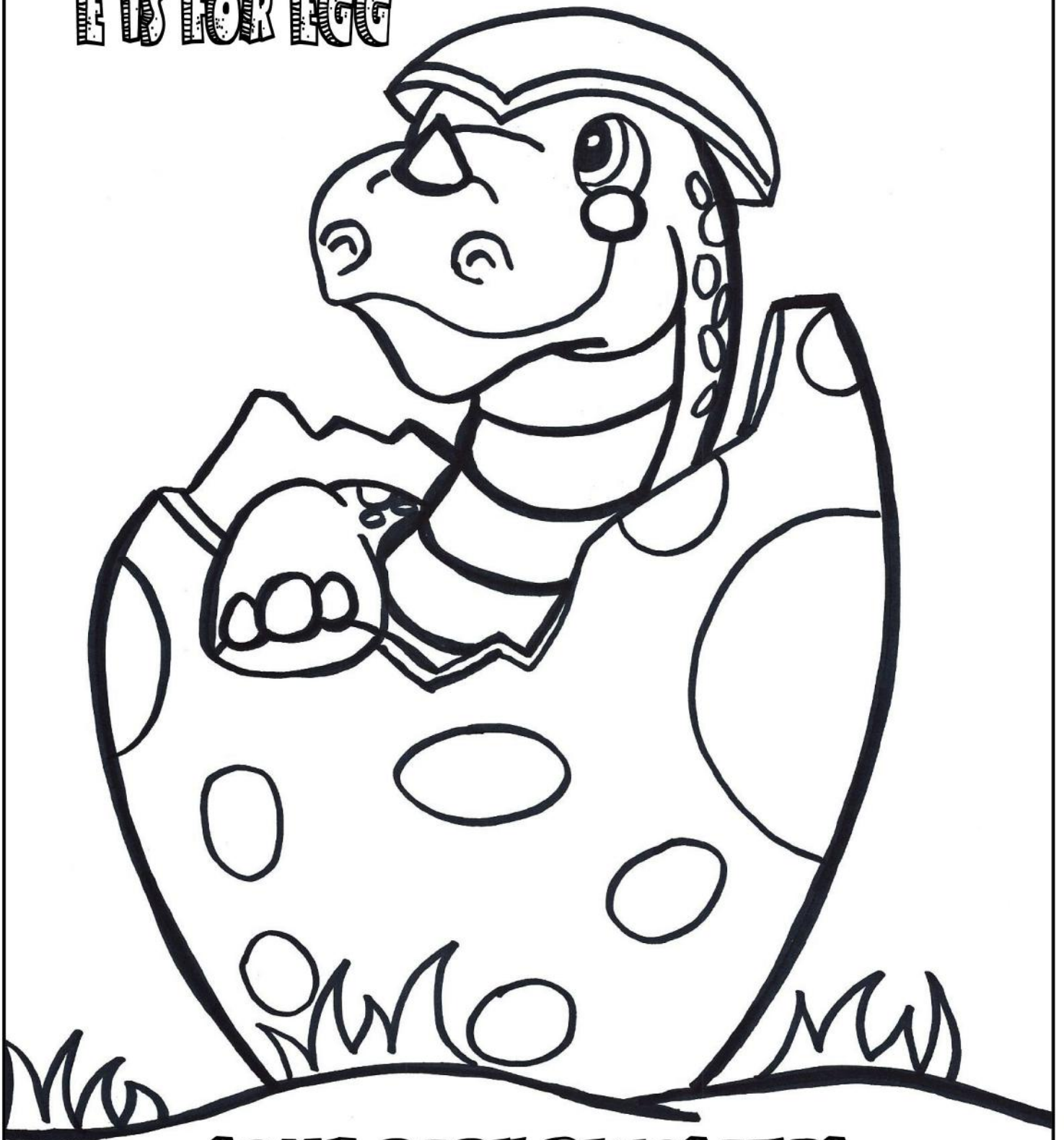


**THE DIPLODOCUS

**E IS FOR EGG**

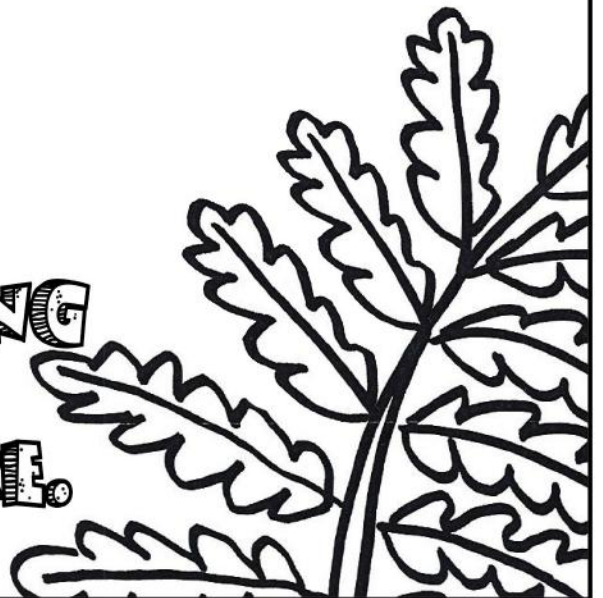


**SOME BABY DINOSAURS

THE FABROSAURUS**

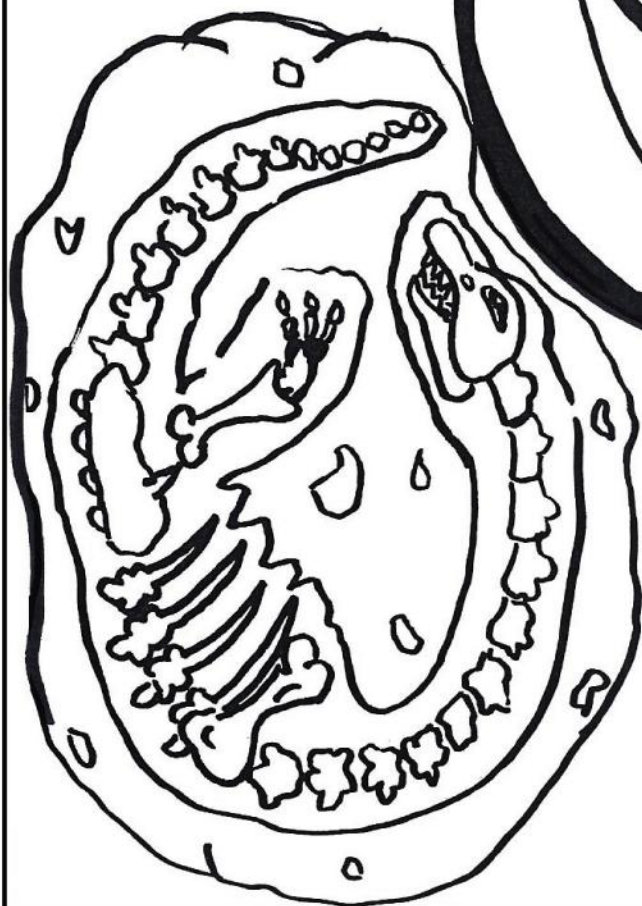


**I AM THE FABULOUS

SEA.

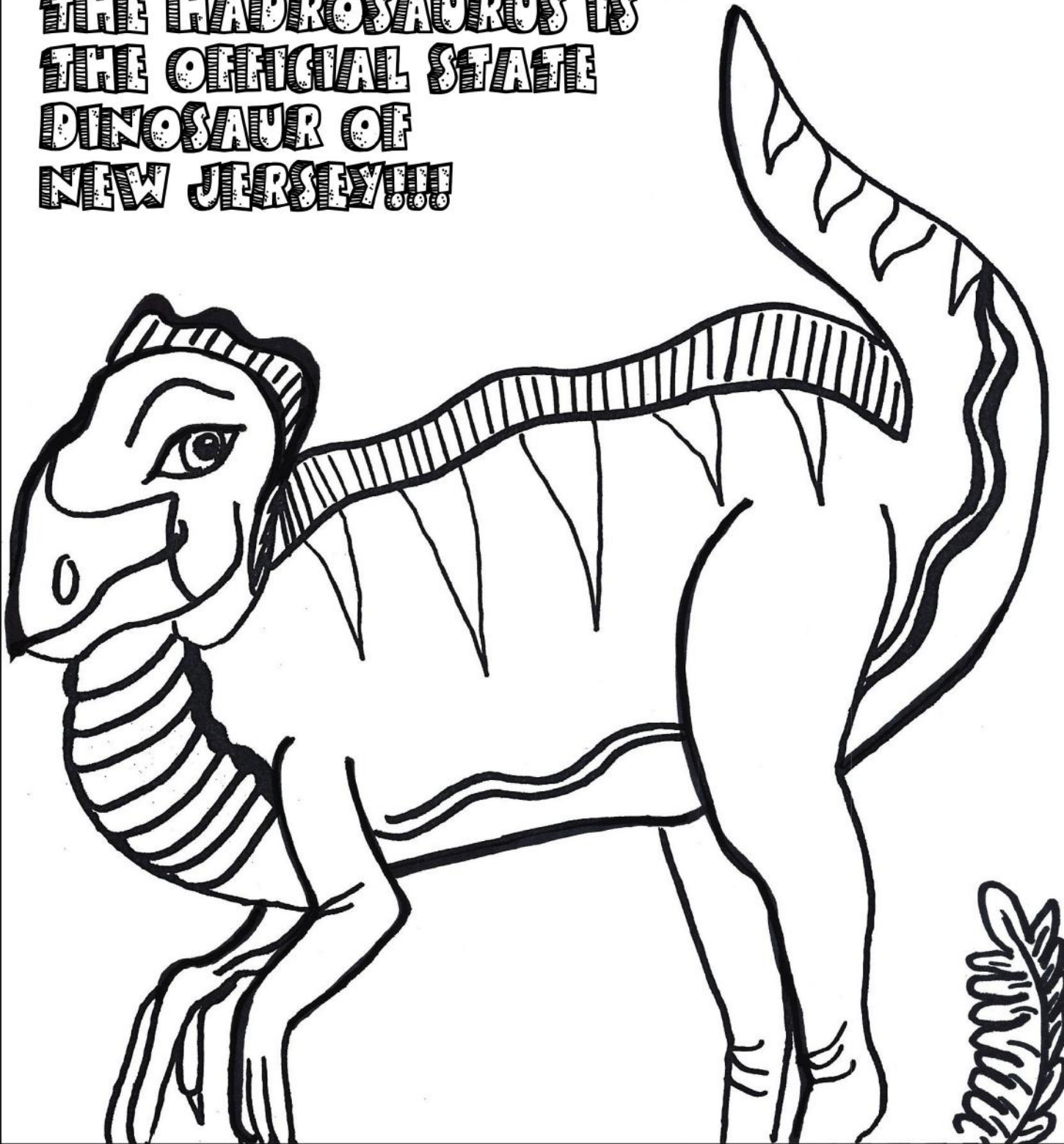

**K IS FOR KENTROSAURUS**



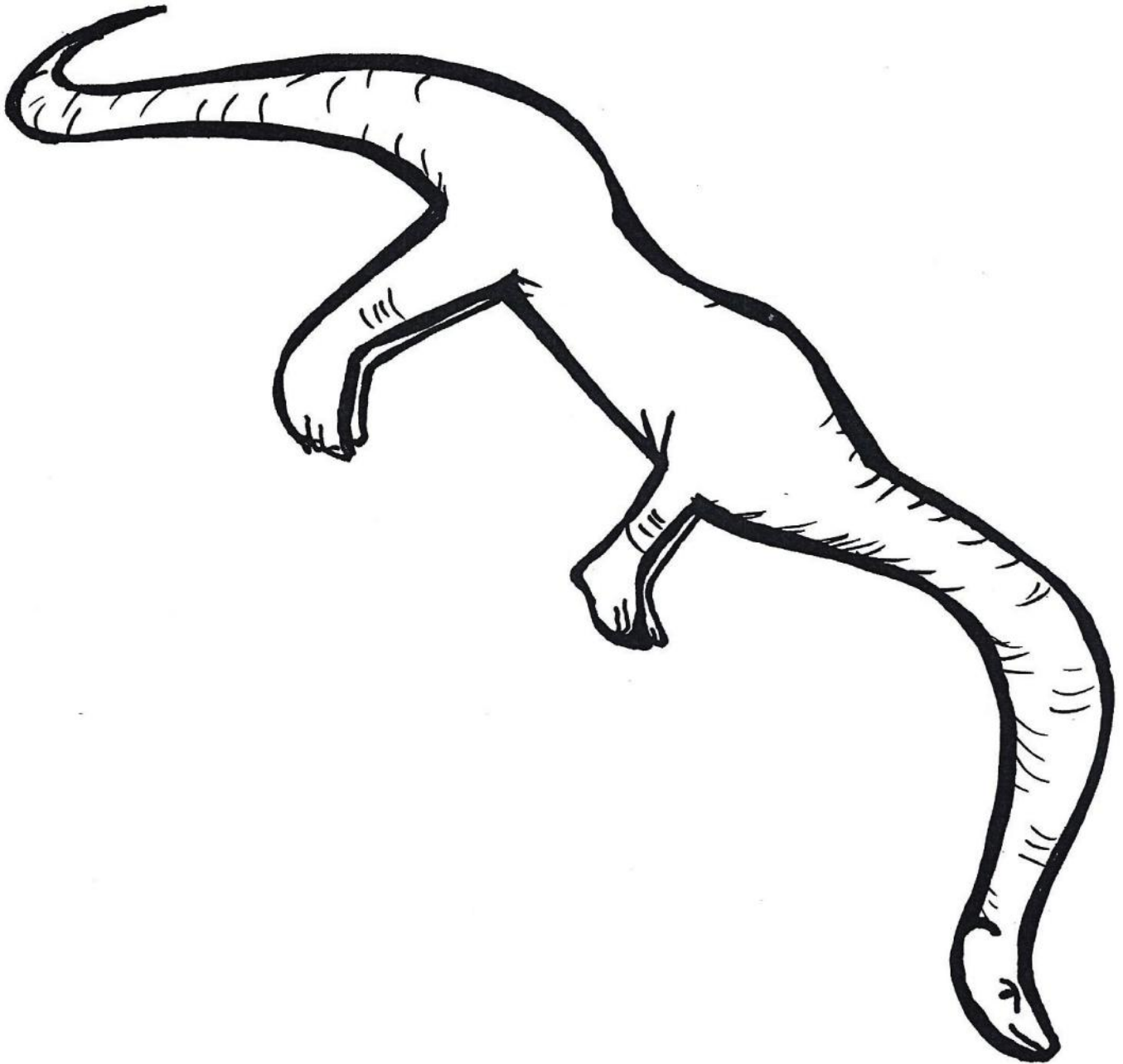
**THE KENTROSAURUS

PERIOD.**

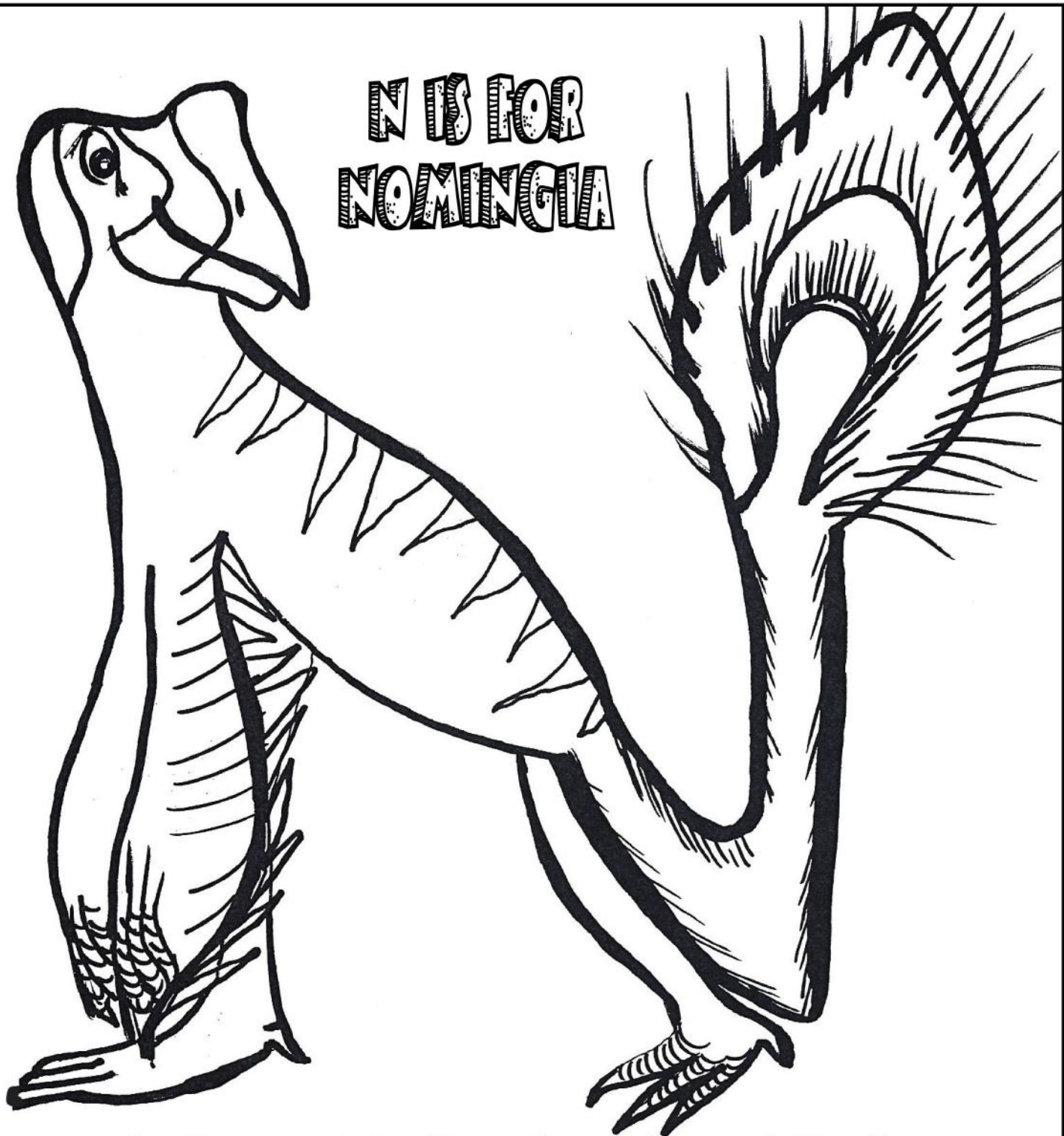


**M IS FOR MASSOSPONDYLUS**



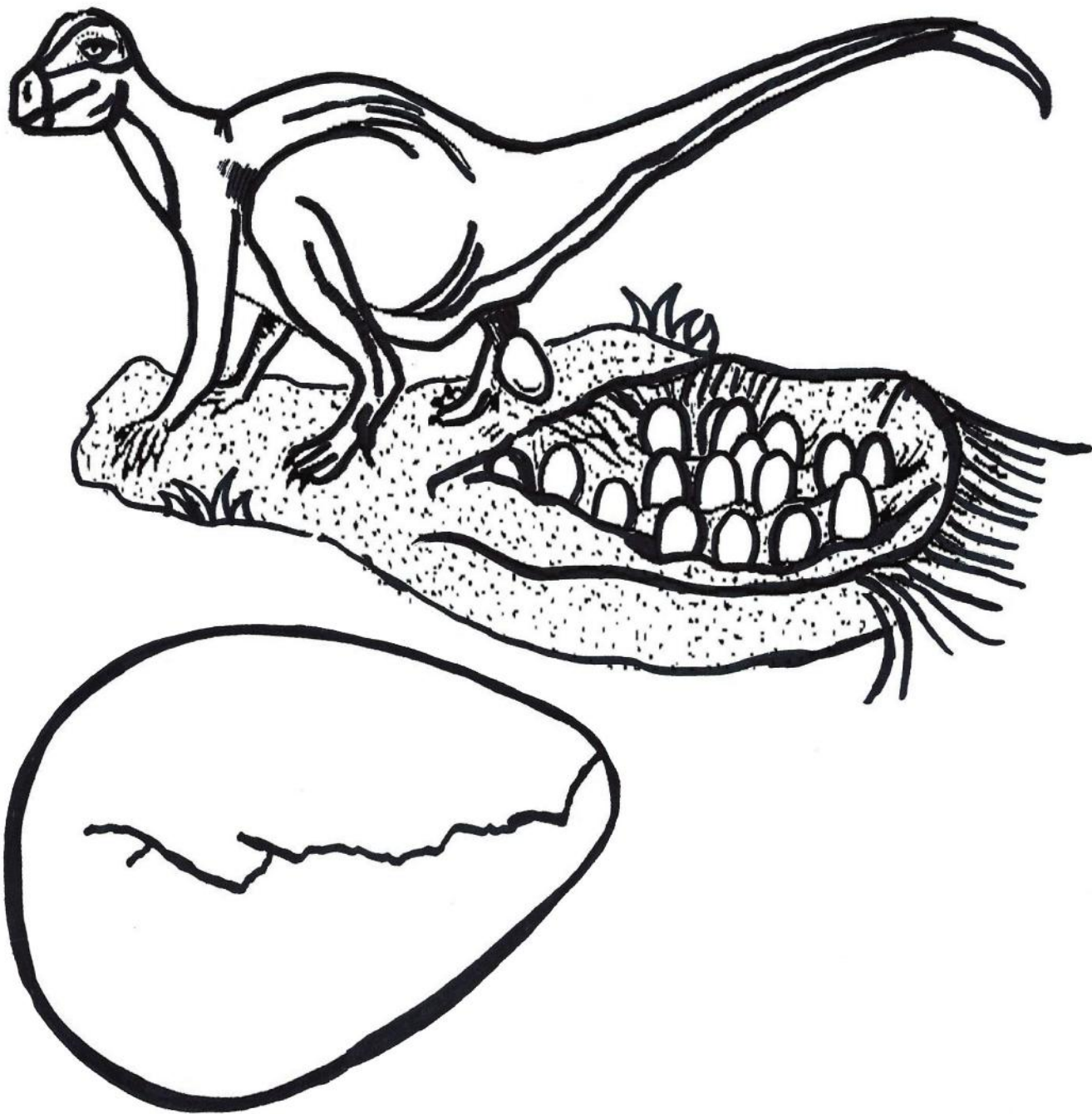
**MASSIVE VERTEBRAE IS THE

**P IS FOR PARASAUROLOPHUS**



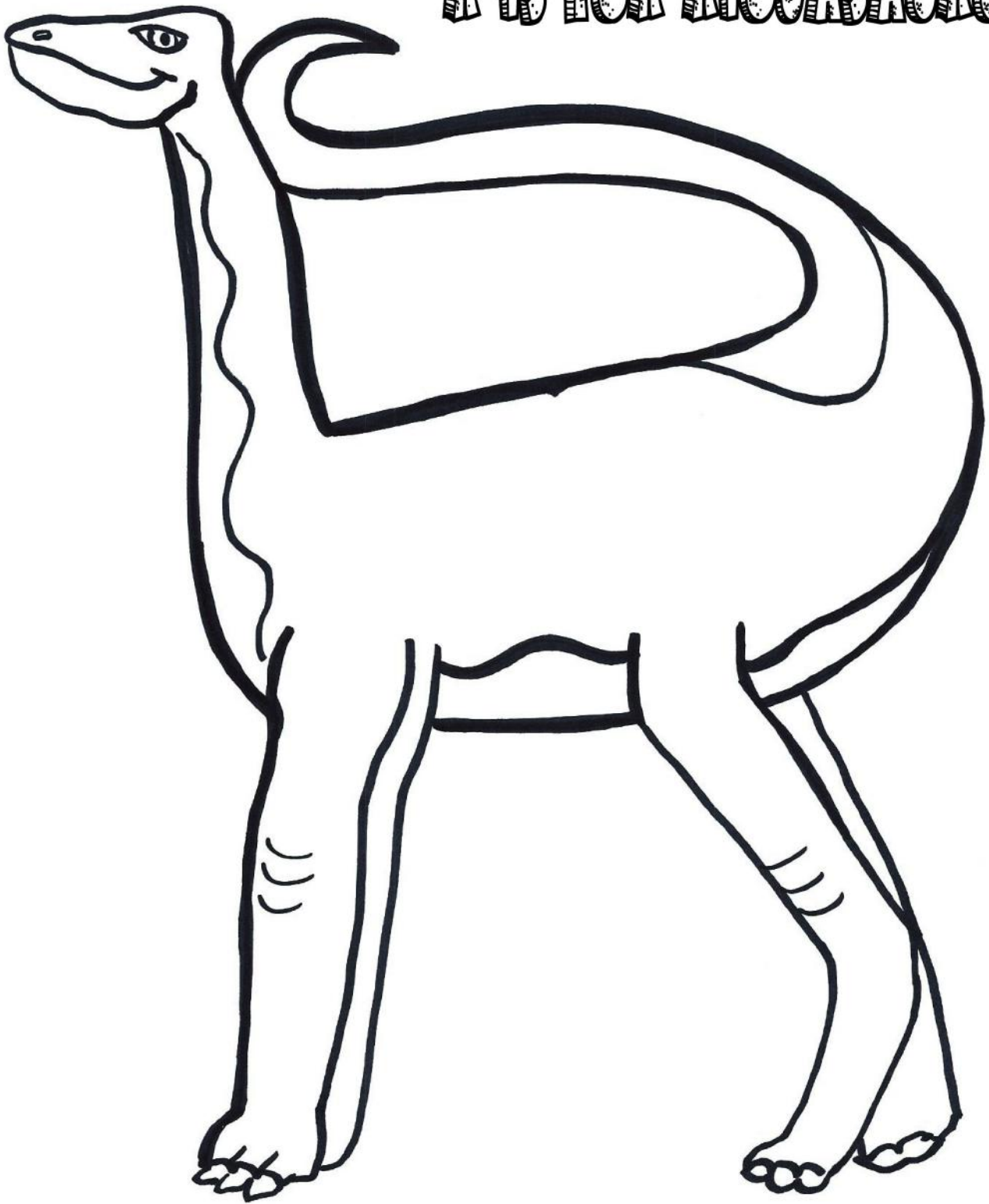
**PARASAUROLOPHUS

# Q IS FOR QUETZALCOATLUS



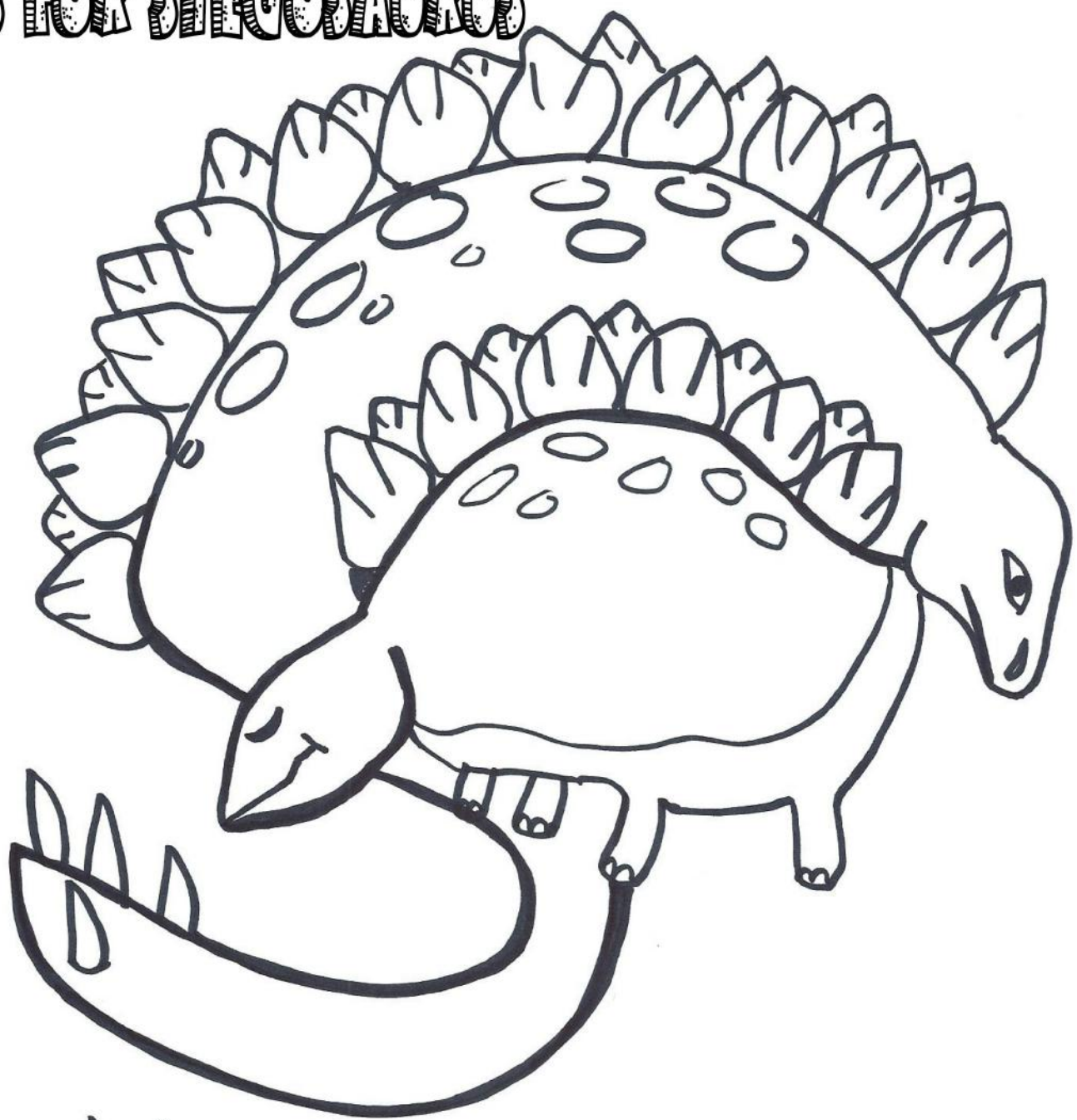
**QUETZALCOATLUS WAS ONE OF

**R IS FOR RIOJASAUURUS**

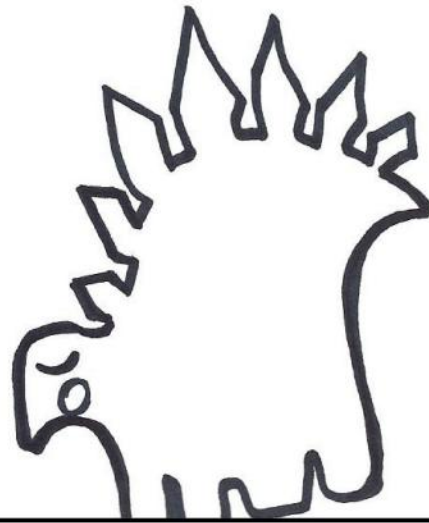


**RIOJASAUURUS WAS ONE OF THE

# T IS FOR TRICERATOPS AND T-REX



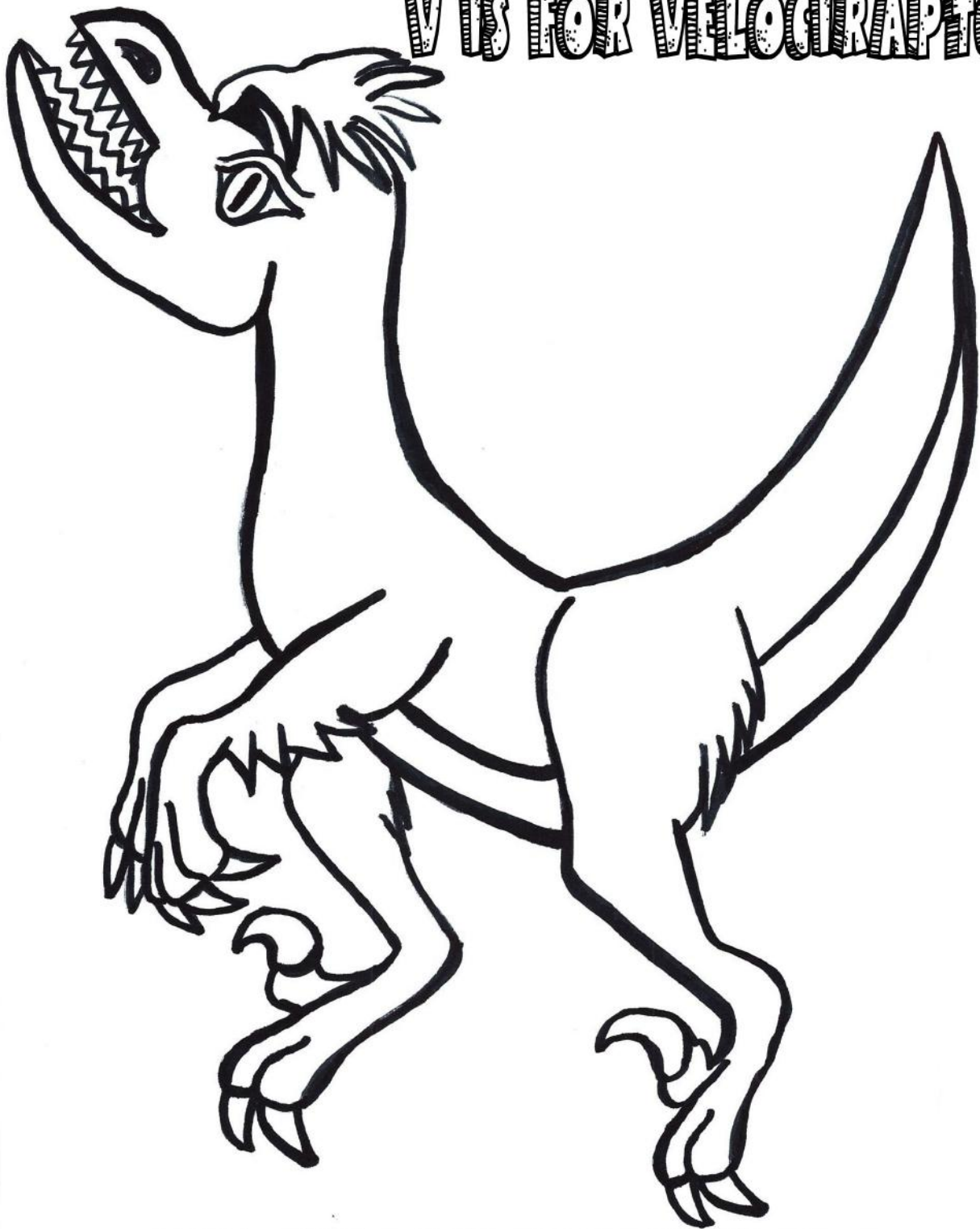
**THE FIERCE T-REX

ULTRASAUURUS**

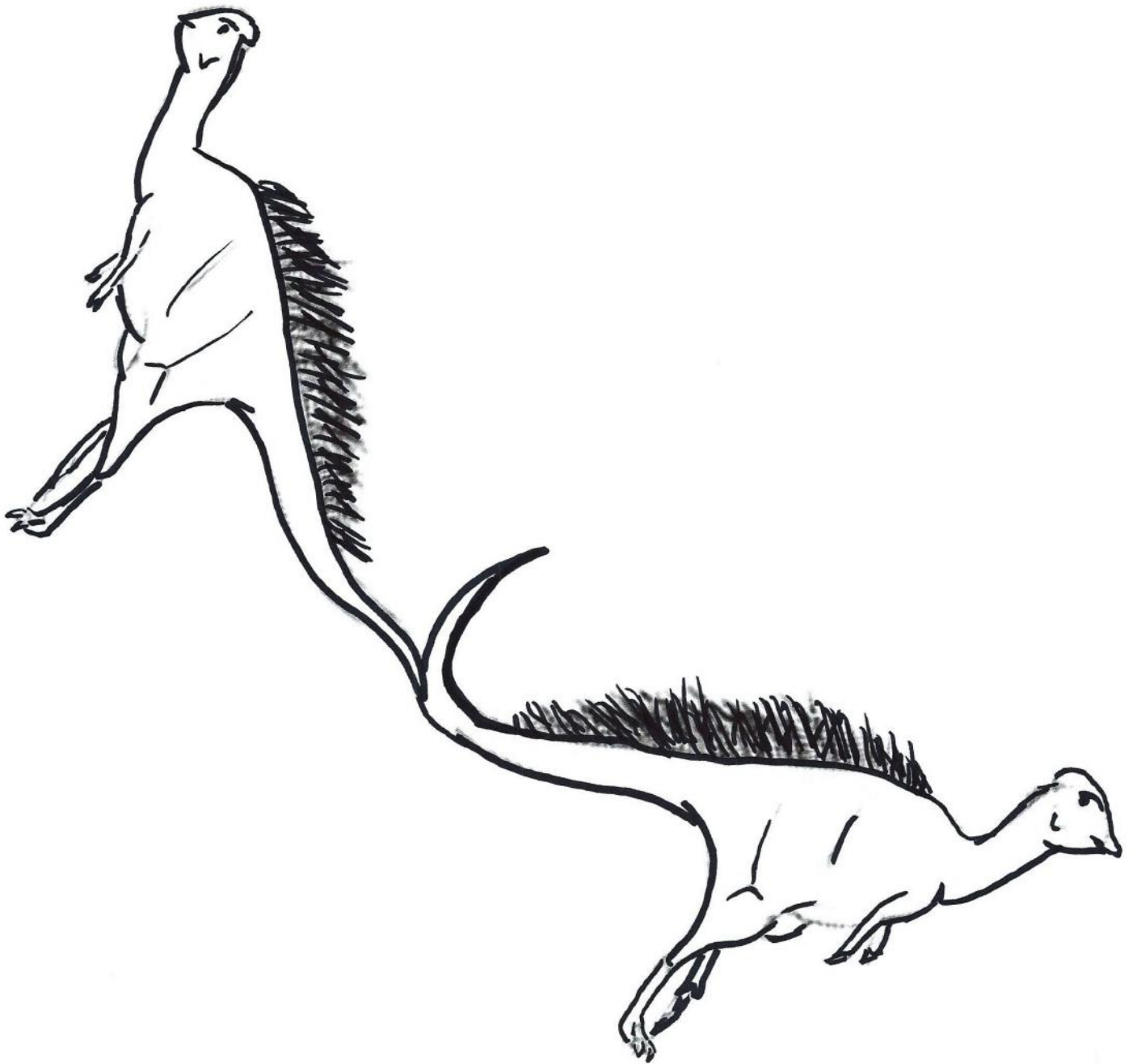
**THIS DINOSAUR HAD

COVERING ALL OVER ITS BODY.**

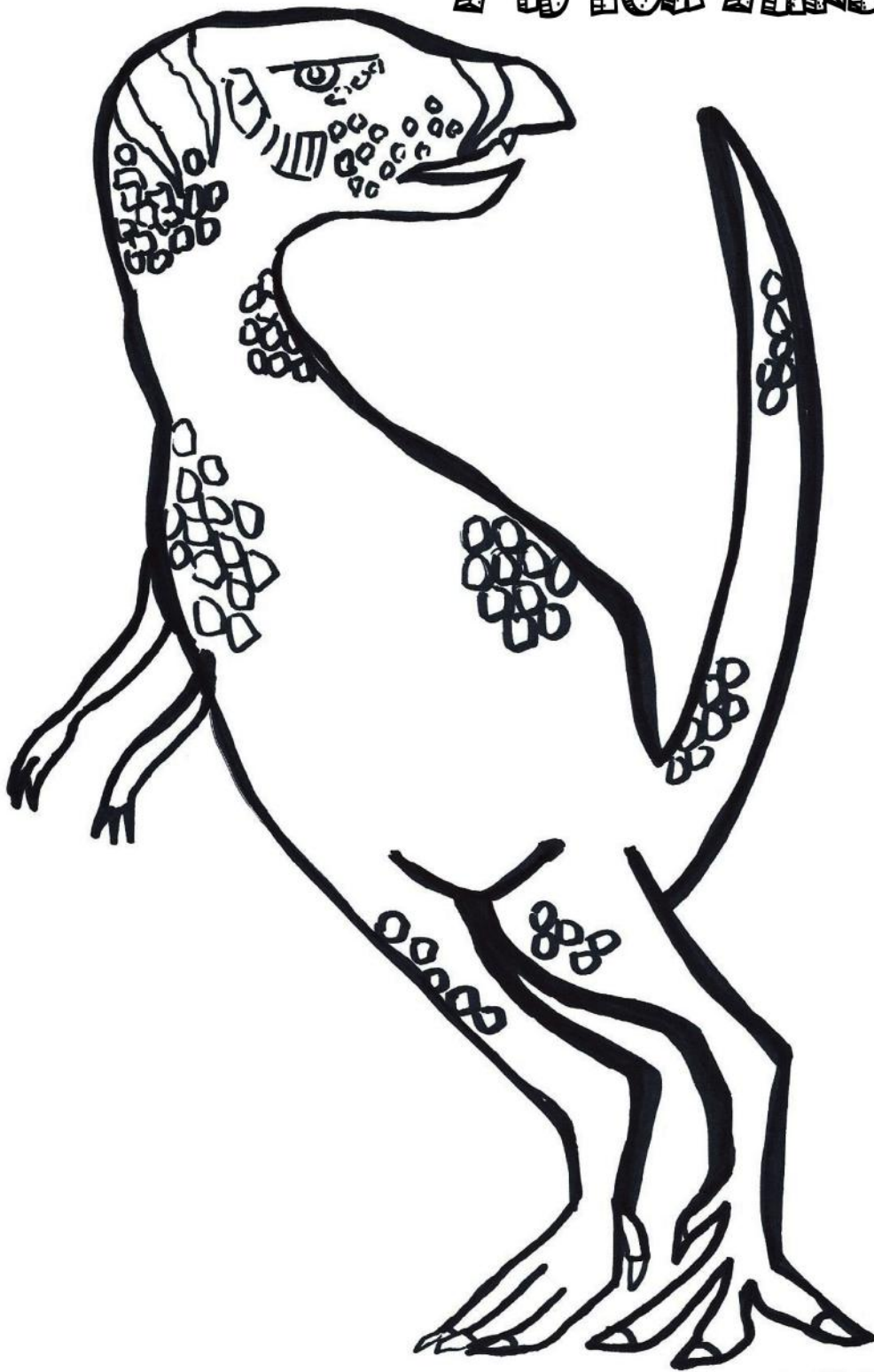
# W IS FOR WANNANOSAURUS
